Tiyyok is a recipient of Leadership of Environment and Development (LEAD), a scholarship on sustainable development, 2004 and Australian Leadership Awards scholarship in 2009. He also won awards in several design competitions, IAI Award in 2024, 2021 and 2018 IAI Jakarta Awards 2020, IAI Banten Awards 2022, and Singapore Institute of Planners Award (SIP) Awards in 2021, 2019 and 2017.
